

DEPUTY COUNTY COUNSEL (UNCLASSIFIED Management)

The Placer County Counsel's office, located in Auburn, is recruiting for two Deputy County Counsel positions. Candidates must be an active member in the California State Bar and have a minimum of two (2) years professional legal experience in one or more of the following practice areas:

- **Financing**: Community facilities district and joint powers authority formation, tax sharing agreements, Mitigation Fee Act, Propositions 218 and 26.
- Land Use: Planning and Zoning Law, Subdivision Map Act, Code Enforcement, CEQA, Water Law, Clean Water and Air Acts.
- **Public Works**: Public Bid process and contracts, construction claims and contractor disputes, Streets & Highways Code issues, roadway dedications and exactions, roadway maintenance and transit.
- **Transaction**: Public contracts, development agreements, subdivision improvement and transfer of development rights agreements, real property purchase and sales agreements, easements, leases and memoranda of understanding between public agencies.

The County Counsel's office is a department of the County of Placer and consists of 22 employees, including 15 attorneys. It is led by the County Counsel, an attorney who is a direct appointment of the Board of Supervisors. The office is a fast-paced, professional environment in which the attorneys assist the County Counsel by providing legal advice and services in a variety of assignments. Deputy County Counsel positions are designated as unclassified, and as such, are at-will employees serving at the will of the County Counsel.

The vacant positions will be filled at either, Deputy County Counsel I, II or III. The position level and starting salary will be determined by candidates qualifications, salary history and career accomplishments.

Experience in a public entity/agency or in the private sector representing a public entity/agency is desirable. Applicants are encouraged to identify in their application material experience and strengths in the above practice areas.
