



Forensic Pathologist (Physician)

THE OPPORTUNITY

The Placer County Sheriff's Office is seeking qualified applicants for one Forensic Pathologist (Physician) vacancy. The Sheriff's Office currently provides Coroner Services for all of Placer County and surrounding Counties as needed. The incumbent will be responsible for determining the cause of death for any case requiring the completion of a Coroner's investigation. The individual will be required to perform postmortem examinations, consult with investigators, review and understand medical records and toxicology results, and provide testimony during legal proceedings.

COMPENSATION

The annual salary range for this position is \$156,060.94 - \$189,693.92. Starting salary will be dependent upon qualifications. Board Certification Pay is an additional 20% of base hourly rate, and Forensic Pathologist Specialization Pay is an additional 15% of base hourly rate. Longevity pay (5 years of service at Step 5) is an additional 5% of base hourly rate.

BENEFITS

The County participates in Social Security and the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS). The County offers health, dental, and vision insurance plans through CalPERS with the County paying 80% of the selected plan's total premium for health, and 100% of the total premium for employee dental and vision insurance.
